

# BASTROP ISD 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR GRADING PERIODS & ELIGIBILITY DATES

Revised 7-7-16

August 22	First day of school.
September 30	End of 6 week grading period. <u>All students</u> will keep or lose eligibility based on these grades.
October 7	Students failing at the 6 week grading period become ineligible at 4:10. Previously ineligible students may regain eligibility at 4:10.
October 21	Grade check for ineligible students only.
October 28	Previously ineligible students may regain eligibility at 4:10.
November 4	End of 6 week grading period. <u>All students</u> will again keep or lose eligibility based on these grades.
November 11	Students failing the 6 week grading period become ineligible at 4:10. Previously ineligible students may regain eligibility at 4:10.
*****	<b>All students (whether currently eligible or ineligible) are eligible to participate during the Thanksgiving Break.</b>
December 2	Grade check for ineligible students only.
December 9	Previously ineligible students may regain eligibility at 4:10.
December 16	End of 6 week grading period. <u>All students</u> will again keep or lose eligibility based on these grades. Eligibility is determined based on the 6 week grade.
*****	<b>All students (whether currently eligible or ineligible) are eligible to participate during the Christmas Break.</b>
January 11	Students failing at the 6 week grading period become ineligible at 4:10. Previously ineligible students may regain eligibility at 4:10.
January 20	Grade check for ineligible students only.
January 27	Previously ineligible students may regain eligibility at 4:10.
February 17	End of 6 week grading period. <u>All students</u> will again keep or lose eligibility based on these grades.
February 27	Students failing at the 6 week grading period become ineligible at 4:10. Previously ineligible students may regain eligibility at 4:10.
March 10	Grade check for ineligible students only.
*****	<b>All students (whether currently eligible or ineligible) are eligible to participate during Spring Break.</b>
March 27	Previously ineligible students may regain eligibility at 4:10.
April 7	End of 6 week grading period. <u>All students</u> will again keep or lose eligibility based on these grades.
April 18	Students failing at the 6 week grading period become ineligible at 4:10. Previously ineligible students may regain eligibility at 4:10.
April 28	Grade check for ineligible students only.
May 5	Previously ineligible students may regain eligibility at 4:10.
May 26	<b>End of 6 week grading period. All students (whether currently eligible or ineligible) are eligible to participate from this point forward.</b>

## **The following items are important to remember:**

- **Students will become eligible or ineligible at the end of the school day seven days from the ending date of the grading period.**
- **Students can regain eligibility at the end of the three-week grading period. They cannot lose eligibility.**
- **In order for students to regain eligibility, the principal and teachers must document that he or she has earned a passing grade (70 or above) in all classes.**
- **Students are eligible during a school holiday of a full calendar week or more (Thanksgiving, Christmas, Spring Break). If a grading period or three-week evaluation period ends on the last class day prior to a school holiday of one calendar week or more (i.e. Thanksgiving, Christmas, Spring Break), the seven calendar days grace period to lose eligibility and the seven calendar day waiting period to regain eligibility begins the first day that classes resume.**
- **Students lose eligibility for a three school week period. For purposes of the law, “three school weeks” is defined as “15” class days. Exception: One, but only one, of the three school weeks may consist of only three or four class days, provided school has been dismissed for a scheduled holiday period. Two class days do not constitute a “school week” for purposes of this law except Thanksgiving week if schools are on holiday Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. A seven calendar day grace period to lose eligibility and a seven calendar day waiting period to regain eligibility are still in effect.**
- **Ineligible student may practice or rehearse with their teams or groups.**
