What are school hours?

What are breakfast procedures?

What should we expect for homework ?

Weekly newsletters are posted on ClassDojo with detailed information on what we are learning and the homework for the week. Reading at home for 20 minutes everyday will tremendously help students grow! Homework will cover skills previously taught. If your child is struggling with homework be sure to let us know! Family time is extremely important to us and we will work hard to not overload the students.

How will teachers contact parents?

We will be using ClassDojo to keep parents in the loop. We'll share photos from class, important updates, and the weekly newsletter. Information on how to sign up will be sent very soon. It's free and takes under a minute. Email and phone calls are also an option but we have found ClassDojo to be amazing for keeping in touch!

How can parents contact teachers?

ClassDojo is the best way to reach us and can be checked a few times a day. Emailing also works great. If needed, you can call the front office. Classroom phones are generally only answered during our planning time from 1:40-2:40 but we are often out and about. Feel free to leave a message with the office and they will page us if need be.

How can I help?

We are always on the lookout for volunteers; in class, on trips, and around the school. Please let us know if you are interested in volunteering in any way. Be sure to stop by the office to sign in. Don't forget VIPS approval is needed prior to attending field trips.
