Course Materials

You will be responsible for providing your own writing utensil, erasers, composition notebook, one folder with pockets.

Calculators

Each student will have access to a Texas Instrument Graphing Calculator in which will remain in the classroom.

Make-Up Work/Exam Policy

Whenever you are absent, it is your responsibility to find out what you missed. See the Assignment (weekly lesson planner) and retrieve lessons from the Make-Up Station or you may see me before and after class. You will have 3 days to make up missed work. If you miss a test you will need to schedule a time before or after school to make up test.

Late Work Policy

All assigned work will be submitted by the due date at the beginning of class. If you do not turn in an assignment, you have 3 days to turn in according to district policy. Turing work in late is discouraged. If your work is late, you may receive up to 70%.

Homework/Classwork

There will be daily classroom assignments as well as homework assignments that will be given as needed.

Tutoring

Tutoring is available before school from 8:05-8:35 on Mondays - Thursdays in room B106. If you are experiencing difficulty with Geometry or any other subject, there are resources available to help you such as (BTB) Beyond the Bell After School Program in which Mrs. Barnett

Attendance

Geometry is a high school course for credit. Attendance is very important, one may lose credit for course if attendance is less than 90% per semester. Students must make up all class-time and work missed in order to receive credit for the class. The makeup time is minute for minute. Students may also do community service to make up time.

Tardy Policy

A tardy will be marked in the gradebook when you arrive to class after the bell has rung. After the first 10 minutes of class you will be counted absent. Each tardy will be entered into Skyward and subsequent consequences will occur. Remember: 3 tardies = 1 absence

Cheating is a serious offense (copying someone else's work on assignments as well as on test). Remember, there will not be anyone to help you when you are testing, so it is important that you learn the material.
