Please note: Teachers have 24-hours during the work week to respond to emails.

Schedule:

- 1st:** Review: subject pronouns, adjectives, present tense endings, ser, estar, tener, ir
- 2nd:** -ar preterite, direct and indirect object pronouns, preterite of ir, ser, hacer, ver, dar
- 3rd:** -er and -ir preterite, demonstrative adjectives and pronouns
- 4th:** reflexive verbs, present progressive, irregular present and preterite verbs
- 5th:** imperfect; preterite vs. imperfect; -car, -gar, -zar; irregular preterite
- 6th:** Tú, Ud., Uds., affirmative and negative commands

Grading:

- *Calentamiento/ Boleto de Salida*-- At the beginning and end of each class, you'll have 5 minutes to complete the posted assignment on the Calentamiento/Boleto de Salida paper that you pick up at the beginning of every other week. It may consist of answering questions, filling in the blank, book work, or something similar. If you complete both assignments for the day, you'll receive full credit. If not, you'll receive a 0 for that day. At the end of the 2 weeks, you'll receive whatever percentage of the assignments you completed. 10 points will be taken off if you lose the given paper. (daily grade)
- Classwork (daily grade)
- Exámenes (major grade)
- One project per 6-weeks (major grade)

Late work:

Assignments will be docked 10 points for each academic day that they are late. If you miss a class, it is YOUR responsibility to pick up missed work. Missing work can be found in the hanging folders near the door.

Class Guidelines and Etiquette:

Entering the classroom:

- Wait outside the classroom until the teacher allows you to enter.
- Greet your teacher in Spanish. (Buenos días, buenas tardes, hola, etc.)
- Put your phone in your pocket or the hanger, remove hats and hoodies, and put away all other technology for the duration of class.
- Grab your notebook and workbook, sit in your assigned seat, and begin the *calentamiento*.
- If the bell has rung, you will not be allowed to enter without a note from the tardy kiosk (across the main hallway from the counselor's office).

During class:

- The door will always be locked. To enter, please knock once and wait patiently.

- You will not be allowed to leave for the first 10 minutes of the class period, the last 10 minutes of the class period, or during Eagle Time. You will not be allowed to leave my class to go to another class (construction, dance, Folkórico, the field house, trainers, etc.)
- Use school-appropriate language (in English, Spanish, or any other language you speak).
- If you eat or drink anything, clean up your own mess.
- Stay in your seat unless given permission.
- If I'm talking, you are not.
- Raise your hand to ask questions or to get out of your seat for any reason (throw away trash, sharpen pencil, etc.).
- Turn in completed assignments into your class' folder on my desk. Write your first and last name on all work! All graded assignments will be in the crate by classes.
- When I need your attention, I will raise my hand. You will then raise your hand and be silent.

Leaving the classroom:

- You will be dismissed by the teacher and not the bell.
- Remain in your seats until instructed by the teacher.
- Before you leave, complete your *boleto de salida*, put away your notebook and workbook, grab your phone (once given permission), and clean up any mess made.

Culture of Class:

I expect you to come prepared with the necessary tools to be successful in this class; to speak Spanish to the **best** of your ability; to be respectful of the classroom, your classmates, yourself, and me; and to speak to me when I've offended you. You can expect the same from me.
