

In the fall of 2019 and 2020, a Citizens Advisory Task Force made up of 59 community members, studied, analyzed, and weighed the current and future needs of Bastrop ISD. The committee considered instructional needs, demographic trends, growth in enrollment, and the district's bond capacity. The task force recommended to the BISD School Board a comprehensive bond package to address these needs, and the school board approved a bond election for \$183,650,000 with no tax rate increase. The bond will be presented on the ballot as two propositions outlined below.

PROPOSITION A: \$177,829,000



GROWTH: NEW SCHOOLS - \$64.380.440

- New elementary school and land in Bastrop
- New elementary school on district-owned land in Cedar Creek



GROWTH: RENOVATION/EXPANSION - \$76.065.235

- Consolidation of Mina Elementary to one side of Hill Street, including additional classrooms, redesigned front entry, dining area, and new playground
- Transformation of intermediate schools to middle schools for grades 6-8
- Expansion and renovation of science labs at middle schools ٠
- Expansion of weight room at middle schools ٠
- New academic wing at BHS and comprehensive master plan
- Renovation of choir and dance classrooms at BHS and expansion of Career & **Technical Education facilities**
- Additional classrooms at CCHS to increase capacity to 2,100 students •
- Technology infrastructure

- · Redesigned school front entries
- Security fencing and access doors for middle school courtyards
- Security curtains on interior windows of identified classrooms at CCHS



GENERAL IMPROVEMENTS - \$27,972,741

- Infrastructure and building system renovations at all schools
- Addition or renovation of concessions, restrooms and dressing rooms for BHS softball & baseball
- Expansion or improvements of parking lots and driveways at elementary schools


