Kindergarten Report Card Expectations

Below is an overview of what students will be assessed on the first grading period.

Language Arts Expectations

By the end of the first grading period, students should

- Know at least 26 out of 52 letters (upper and lower case)
- Know the sound for at least 13 letters
- Know at least 20 high frequency words
- · Identify the beginning sound in a word
- Identify the front/back of a book, top/bottom of the page, show where to start reading, frame a letter, frame a word, and identify capital letters in text.
- Write their first names correctly on baseline (student should spell their name correctly with appropriate capitalization)
- Listen to a short story and answer questions provided.

Reading goal is to read at instructional level A (example below).

Math Expectations

By the end of the first grading period, students should

- Read, write, and represent numbers 0-5.
- Compose (to create by putting the parts together) the numbers 3-5 (example : 2 and 2 make 4; 3 and 1 make 4)
- Count to 30 orally
- Count sets of objects up to 10 (one-to-one correspondence).
- Identify attributes (characteristics used to describe an object) of: circle, square, triangle, and rectangle.
- Sort shapes by attributes
