Kindergarten Report Card Expectations

Below is an overview of what students will be assessed on the 2nd grading period.

Language Arts Expectations

By the end of the second grading period, students should

- Know all 52 (upper and lower case)
- Know the sound for all letters
- Know at least 31 high frequency words
- Identify the ending sound in a word
- Blend sounds to form a word. For example, /b/-/a/-/t/ says "bat"
- Identify rhyming words
- Draws detailed pictures to represent ideas
- Begins to use letter sound connections to make simple words in writing.

Reading goal is to read at instructional level B (example below).

Math Expectations

By the end of the second grading period, students should

- Read, write, and represent numbers 0-10
- Compose (to create by putting the parts together) the numbers 6-10 (example: 3 and 3 make 6; 2 and 4 make 6) Decompose
- Decompose (breaking numbers apart) the numbers 2-5
- (example: if you have 5 blocks, hide them and then keep 2 hidden, show the 3 blocks - How many do I have hidden?)
- Count to 60 orally
- Count forward to 10 from any number
- Count backwards to 0 from any number less than 10
- Generates a number that is one more or one less than a number given.
- Name and Identify attributes (characteristics used to describe an object) of: sphere, cube, cone, cylinder
- Sort 3D shapes by attributes
