

Kindergarten Report Card Expectations

Below is an overview of what students will be assessed on the 3rd grading period.

Language Arts Expectations

By the end of the third grading period, students should

- Know at least 42 high frequency words
- Demonstrate listening comprehension (listen to a story and respond to questions)
- Segment sounds in a word. For example, "bat" is /b/-/a/-/t/
- Produce rhyming words
- Forms all capital letters correctly
- Writes first and last name correctly

Reading goal is to read at instructional level C (example below).

She was sleeping on the rug.
I said, "Wake up,
Socks."



Math Expectations

By the end of the third grading period, students should

- Read, write, and represent numbers 0-15/counts 1 to 1 up to 20
- Decompose (breaking numbers apart) the numbers 6-10
- (example: if you have 7 blocks, hide them and then keep 2 hidden, show the 5 blocks - How many do I have hidden?)
- Count to 100 by tens
- Count forward to 20 from any number
- Count backwards to 0 from any number less than 20
- Generates a number that is one more or one less than a number given
- Constructs and uses a graph to respond to questions given.
- Models addition and subtraction problem when given problem orally
- Identify the longest or shortest object in a group
- Identify which object weighs more/less in a group
