

# Kindergarten Report Card Expectations

Below is an overview of what students will be assessed on the 4<sup>th</sup> grading period.

## Language Arts Expectations

By the end of the fourth grading period, students should

- Know 60 high frequency words
- Demonstrate listening comprehension (listen to a story and respond to questions)
- Forms all lower case letters correctly
- Dictates/writes a sentence to tell a story

Reading goal is to read at instructional level D (example below).

The pig went in the little house. The pig said, "What a nice little house!"



## Math Expectations

By the end of the fourth grading period, students should

- Read, write, and represent numbers 0-20
- Generates a number that is one more or one less than a number given
- Count to 100 by ones
- Models addition and subtraction problem when given a number sentence (up to 5)
- Identify the coins: penny, nickel, dime, quarter
- Constructs and uses a graph to answer questions
- Identify the longest or shortest object in a group
- Identify which object weighs more/less in a group
