SHAC Officer Roles & Responsibilities:

CHAIR (Appointed)

- Determines agendas for regular and other plenary meetings of the SHAC.
- Presides over the meetings and ensures the SHAC procedures are followed.
- ★ Sign letters, reports, and other communications on behalf of the SHAC.
- ★ Ensure that adequate facilities arrangements and staff support are secured for all meetings.
- Provide members and support staff with agendas and background materials prior to meetings.
- ★ Serve as custodian of all SHAC records. Agendas and minutes of regular meetings must be maintained for a minimum of two years. In addition, the Chair shall keep a record of member term expirations and length of member service.
- ★ Promote public awareness of the SHAC and consult a database of persons interested in service as SHAC members.
- * Inform Trustees of member vacancies.
- ★ Provide staff support in the development and submission of SHAC's annual report.
- ★ Monitor member attendance, and address possible member conflicts of interest and possible instances of undue advantage.
- * Maintain the SHAC website.
- ★ Provide such other assistance as requested in accordance with the SHAC authorizing statute, district policy, and the direction of the Board of Trustees

CO-CHAIR (Designated)

- * Must be a non-district employee.
- * Must be a parent of a student currently enrolled in BISD.
- ★ With the chair and other officers, determine agendas for regular and other plenary meetings of the SHAC.
- ★ Co-preside over the meetings and ensure the SHAC procedures are followed.
- ★ May be asked to sign letters, reports, and other communications on behalf of the SHAC.
- ★ At times, may serve as a spokesperson for the SHAC for inquiries by stakeholders or for presentations.
- * When needed, present progress reports to the Board of Trustees.
- * Perform other responsibilities as may be prescribed by the Board of Trustees or their designee.

TEC, Title 2, Chapter. 28, 28.004

CHAIR-ELECT (Designated)

- ★ With the chair and other officers, determine agendas for regular and other plenary meetings of the SHAC.
- ★ Once subcommittees have been established, oversee the membership and operations of the subcommittees (refer to Article Three, Section Four).
- * Presiding over meetings of the SHAC in the absence of the chair and/or co-chairs.

SECRETARY (Designated)

- ★ In coordination with other officers, the secretary will collaborate and help determine agendas for regular and other plenary meetings of the SHAC.
- ★ Work with the chair to prepare meeting notices and minutes, and arrange the location of SHAC meetings.
- * May preside over meetings of the SHAC in the absence of both the chair and co-chair.

SHAC Officer Roles &

Responsibilities

- Requires a 2 year commitment
 - This year being Year 1
- \star The Co-Chair MUST:
 - Not be employed by the District
 - Have a child currently enrolled in BISD
- \star The Chair-Elect:
 - Oversee the membership & operations of the subcommittees
 - Any Questions?

★ Adult Well-Being

- The local school health advisory council's duties include recommending:
 - Policies, procedures, strategies, and curriculum appropriate for specific grade levels designed to address school employee wellness

★ Substance & Alcohol Abuse

- The local school health advisory council's duties include recommending:
 - Policies, procedures, strategies, and curriculum appropriate for specific grade levels designed to prevent physical health concerns regarding instruction on substance abuse prevention







Vision (The dream)


- 1. To promote a healthy school community where students are safe and supportive.


