# Requirements

Students will provide a black fitted top, black or tan dance shoes, black leggings, and spiral notebook. Fitted Top/Leotard may be full strap, cap sleeve, 3/4 sleeves, or full sleeve with boat neck. Students may NOT wear any articles of clothing with any types of marks, writing, or colors on their dance clothes. SWEAT PANTS or SHORT SHORTS, or ATHLETIC SHORTS OF ANY KIND MAY NOT BE WORN \*You may purchase these from Mrs. Robbins, online, or at an athletic/dance store (Wal-Mart or Academy).

#### Shoes are a requirement. Students may wear any of the following

- Black Jazz Shoes (Required for Performances)
- Tan Jazz Shoes
- Twyla Lyrical Shoes
- Ballet Shoes
- Approved dance sneaker or boot







# **Purpose of Course**

Dance education strives to develop the student as a dance participant and an educated audience member. The course introduces the student to various forms of dance technique, dance history, and the creative process.

Through daily participation in physical activities, the student will learn various dance forms such as fitness, hip hop, modern, ballet, jazz, tap, drill team, choreography and performance

Students will develop and refine motor skills, coordination and kinesthetic awareness. They will develop self-confidence through performance. Students will enhance their understanding of the aesthetics of dance presentations.

#### **Grading Procedures**

Grades are determined by:

- Daily participation and citizenship
- Performance Skills Tests
- Written Tests

If a student is absent, he/she is expected to make up their test upon return to campus.

## **Suggestions for Parents**

The student will be successful in this course if she or he will stretch daily and practice dance combinations at home. The student should maintain an organized dance notebook for all written assignments and tests

Notes, video, and/or music may be sent home/uploaded onto a YouTube page for practice.

Tutorials will take place Thursday or Friday after school. \*\*Student must request one on one time with teacher

# **Dance Class Expectations and Procedures**

#### **Roll Check**

Students should be in the classroom when the tardy bell sounds and begin on the warmup assigned (if applicable for the day). Students will have an additional 5 minutes to change into attire and go to the restroom after the warmup has been completed. STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO LOCK UP ALL BELONGINGS AND PERSONAL ITEMS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE DANCE ROOM. After 5 minutes, students should be in their roll check lines. At the end of the class, students will be allowed to go to the restroom. All students must remain in the dance room until the bell rings. Failure to follow these rules will result in disciplinary action.

#### **Dance Attire**

Daily class attire for all students is all black. NO cover-ups of any kind are allowed unless the teacher gives special permission. Hair should be off neck and NO heavy or dangling jewelry is to be worn. (Mrs. Robbins sells hair ties for .10 cents or student will be given a rubber band if hair is not pulled back.)

#### **Student Participation**

Each student must dress out and participate every day. Parental notes will excuse a student from physical participation for ONE day. A physician's note is required for any circumstance that the student needs to sit out of activities for more than one day. Those students that are not physically participating will be given written assignments.

#### The procedures for tardiness

- Students will be marked tardy if not in the dance room when the bell rings
- Student will lose 10 points off their weekly grade if they are not seated in roll call lines after designated dress out time

#### The procedures NOT dressing out

- Students will have 5 minutes to dress out at the beginning and end of class
- Students should use the restroom in the 5 minutes and will not be allowed to use the restroom until after warmup stretches.
- Students who do not dress out are expected to sign and acknowledge that they have not dressed out for the class period.

#### The procedure for failure to participate

- Students will lose points and given a written assignment they chose not to stretch or dance
- If a reoccurring problem occur parent contact will be made and detention will be assigned.

#### **Point deductions**

If a student does not dress for class and/or does not participate, the students will have 20 points deducted from the weekly participation grade. If a student does not dress out on a skills test day, daily point deductions will be taken off test grade.

# Other point deductions for infractions are as follows:

- 10 points Incorrect top or incorrect bottoms
- 20 points In class work, ISS assignment, or alternative school assignments not completed
- 1 to 20 points Poor participation or unsatisfactory conduct in class or in dressing area

#### **Correct Dance Classroom Etiquette Behaviors**

- Come prepared and ready to dance
- Participate in all dance stretches, across the floor, combos, and try your hardest
- Raise hand before speaking and talking out of turn
- Phones are not permitted
- Stay in area assigned to you in and outside of the dance room
- Respect and encourage everyone in the class

#### Cedar Creek D.A.N.C.E.R. Expectations

- DRESS OUT
- Actively Listen
- **N**o Gum, Food, or Sugary Drinks permitted in dance space
- **C**ommunicate kindly
- **E**njoy the moment
- Respect your space

#### **General Rules** Please DO NOT:

- Touch any AV equipment without permission. Connect Bluetooth or Play music on the sound system without permission
- Leave belongings overnight unlocked.
- Horseplay in the dance room or locker room.
- Leave the room without the teacher's consent.
- Forget that trash belongs in the trash can.
