Health Guidance from TEA (updated 7/7)

INFORM

Provide notice to parents/staff of plan

Identify a point person

Ensure parents understand 90% attendance requirement

Share instructional options for families

PREVENT

Screen staff, students, visitors for exposure & symptoms

Lab-confirmed cases must stay home & meet established criteria to return*

Isolate students who show symptoms and disinfect affected area

RESPOND

Notify local health authority of confirmed positive

Close off areas heavily used by individual (unless 3 days have passed)

Notify staff and families of lab-confirmed case at school

MITIGATE

Hand washing/sanitizing

Respiratory etiquette

Frequent cleaning

Protocol training for students/staff

Face coverings

Physical distancing where possible

Entry/exit/transitions

Meal service locations

Bus safety measures

Limitations on campus visitors

Limitations on in-person meetings

*at least 3 days since recovery (without fever), improvement in symptoms, at least 10 days since symptoms first appeared



Instructional Guidance from TEA (updated 7/7)

IN PERSON



100% on campus with traditional bell schedule M-F

Available for students in PK-12

Funding is measured by daily attendance just like it is currently

REMOTE SYNCHRONOUS

100% online with 2-way, real-time teacher & student interaction

Available for students in grades 3-12 only

Funding measured solely by daily minutes:

- 180 minutes (gr 3-5) or
- 240 minutes (gr 6-12)

REMOTE ASYNCHRONOUS



100% online with live interaction with teacher, recorded lessons, or other online resources

Available for students in PK-12

Student & teacher may or may not be online at the same time

Funding measured by daily student progress, teacher/student interaction, or completed assignments
