Purpose

Bastrop ISD is pleased to offer this guide for programming to provide both enrichment and remediation for BISD students during the summer months. This guide is intended to present all options for summer programming and learning for Bastrop ISD elementary students during the months of June - August 2020. Please note that some dates are subject to change based on future guidance from state and local health officials.

Jump Start Summer School

The following groups of students will be encouraged to participate in a three-week Jump Start summer school at their respective elementary school from July 20 - August 6:

- Any student PK-4 with an “Incomplete” grade for reading and/or math classes.
- Any student who was a struggling learner during the fall semester of the 2019-2020 school year.
- Any student who had attendance concerns during the fall semester of the 2019-2020 school year and who did not participate consistently or at all in At-Home Learning via Google Classroom or Paper Packet Instruction.

Jump Start programming will follow a summer school schedule as follows:

- Monday - Thursday from 7:30 am - 12:30 pm.
- Transportation provided to summer school bus stops.
- Breakfast and lunch provided.

PK- 4 Paper Packets for Summer School : July 20 - August 6

BISD will offer paper packets for summer school students who have ended the spring semester or year with a grade designation of Incomplete “I”. These packets will be made available for students who are not able to attend our summer programming offered at each of our six elementary campuses.

Extended School Year (ESY) Services for Students in Special Education

Extended School Year (ESY) services is an individualized instructional program for eligible students with disabilities that is provided beyond the regular school year. The need for ESY services must be determined on an individual basis by the admission, review, and dismissal (ARD) committee.

Bastrop ISD will offer Extended School Year Services during the July 20 - August 6 Jump Start program dates. Each student’s schedule will be based on their unique needs as determined by the ARD Committee. Summer School Program for English Learners (ELs) in Pre-K & Kindergarten

The Pre-K and Kindergarten Bilingual Summer Program is an opportunity for students to receive instruction designed to prepare them to be successful in Kindergarten and First Grade. Students who were enrolled (or are enrolling) in Prek and Kindergarten bilingual/ESL classrooms are eligible to participate however, they must reside in the Bastrop attendance zones.

Texas statute requires 120 hours of programming for PK & Kindergarten bilingual/ESL students. Therefore, our summer programming will be a blended model consisting of both in person classes and online resources. In addition, our bilingual/ESL PK & K students will also be a part of their schools Jump Start program from July 20 - August 6.

CIS Virtual Summer Camp

CIS staff will continue ongoing case management with 20-25% of their caseload (roughly between 16-20 students) until June 23. During the week of June 8th and the week of June 15th, Program Managers will continue to facilitate summer programming with their students by having individual sessions, group sessions and/or facilitate "camp-like" activities with the students. CIS has partnered with Camp Capers and will be sending activity kits to all students who are able to participate in programming.

ACE Virtual Summer Camp

Buckle up for an amazing all American "Virtual Road Trip"! Interested BISD students in grades K-4 will participate in a cross country trip (from their couch) to explore the beauty and diversity of America. From Louisiana, Alaska, Kentucky and beyond the kids will learn about our country through at-home kits that include crafts, cooking projects and science activities led by our ACE coordinators.

The ACE program will operate June 1-July 9 through Google Classroom and include opportunities for students to interact with coordinators and each other in a virtual format. Lesson plan packets, available in both English and Spanish, and supply kits will be provided free of charge for pick up every two weeks from designated locations.

STARS Summer Programming

STARS offers childcare and academic enrichment for children ages 4-13 in a safe, DFPS approved setting. Participants will explore regions of the United States through various cooking, arts and crafts, science and team building activities. Care is available throughout the summer, Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. - 6:30 p.m. Due to social distancing guidelines, registration is currently limited to 54 students at Mina Elementary and 36 at Bluebonnet Elementary with priority given to those seeking full-time care. Adjustments may be made to the number of children and types of activities permitted as new state and local guidelines become available.
