Students who require credit recovery will be contacted by their respective campus personnel and encouraged to begin Edgenuity classes starting Monday, June 1, 2020. Virtual summer school teachers will be hired and available to support students working through Edgenuity credit recovery classes. Students may access Edgenuity through their smartphones or Chromebook devices checked out from school. In order to receive full credit for Edgenuity classes, students must complete their assigned courses by Friday, July 3.

Once again, unless otherwise noted above, in order for students to receive full credit for Edgenuity credit recovery classes, they must be completed by Friday, July 3, 2020.

EOC Paper Packets

Teachers have identified students currently enrolled in a course that also has an End-of-Course (EOC) STAAR test requirement who would benefit from having a paper packet in order to complete course credit.

Students who successfully complete their assigned packet(s) and earn course credit for any currently enrolled EOC course(s) by July 3 will be exempt from the STAAR graduation requirement for the course(s). If credit is not earned by July 3, then the student must take the STAAR test for that course(s) in December 2020.

BISD will mail the EOC packets to students, along with an addressed, prepaid, stamped envelope. Completed packet(s) must be returned in this envelope by Friday, July 3, 2020.

Jump Start Summer School

The following groups of students will be encouraged to participate in a three-week Jump Start summer school at their respective high school from July 20 - August 6:

- Any student with an Incomplete:No Participation (I:NP) grade for a core course needed for graduation.
- Any student who did not return or successfully complete their EOC paper packet(S) by the July 3
 deadline.
- Any student who did not return or successfully complete their Core Class paper packet(s) by the July 3
 deadline.
- Any student who did not successfully complete an assigned Edgenuity course for credit recovery by the July 3 deadline.

Jump Start programming will follow a summer school schedule as follows:

- Monday Thursday from 8:00 am 1:00 pm.
- Transportation provided to summer school bus stops.
- Breakfast and lunch provided.

Extended School Year (ESY) Services for Students in Special Education

Extended School Year (ESY) services is an individualized instructional program for eligible students with disabilities that is provided beyond the regular school year. The need for ESY services must be determined on an individual basis by the admission, review, and dismissal (ARD) committee.

Bastrop ISD will offer Extended School Year Services during the July 20 - August 6 Jump Start program dates. Each student's schedule will be based on their unique needs as determined by the ARD Committee. Newcomer English Learner Camp

Students new to the United States (less than 3 years in U.S. schools) who require additional instruction for English language development can choose to receive support from July 20 through August 6 at their respective

Support for students will include individualized instruction through small, teacher-led groups, vocabulary acquisition and word study, and practice using vocabulary through the 4 domains of language.
