BISD Summer School Guide for Middle School Students 2019-2020

Purpose

Bastrop ISD is pleased to offer this guide for programming to provide both enrichment and remediation for BISD students during the summer months. This guide is intended to present all options for summer programming and learning for Bastrop ISD Middle School Students during the months of June - August 2020. Please note that some dates are subject to change based on future guidance from state and local health officials.

Jump Start Summer School

The following groups of students will be encouraged to participate in a three-week Jump Start summer school at their respective Middle School from July 20 - August 6:

- Any student in 7th or 8th grade with an “Incomplete” grade for reading and/or math classes.
- Any student who was a struggling learner during the fall semester of the 2019-2020 school year.
- Any student who had attendance concerns during the fall semester of the 2019-2020 school year and who did not participate consistently or at all in At-Home Learning via Google Classroom or Paper Packet Instruction.
- Any student who earned an Incomplete:No Participation (I:NP) grade for a core course for high school credit.

Jump Start programming will follow a summer school schedule as follows:

- Monday - Thursday from 7:45 am - 12:45 pm.
- Transportation provided to summer school bus stops.
- Breakfast and lunch provided.

Pre-AP Math Enrichment Camp During Jump Start

Middle school students who will be enrolling in 7th grade Pre-AP math or Algebra I in the 2020-2021 school year will have an opportunity to participate in a Pre-AP Math Enrichment Camp as a part of Jump Start programming from July 20 - August 6. Students must have taken 6th grade Pre-AP or 7th Grade Pre-AP math during the 2019-2020 school year to be eligible for the Pre-AP Math Enrichment Camp.

Interested students may inquire with their middle school to register.

7TH & 8TH Paper Packets for Summer School : July 20 - August 6

BISD will offer paper packets for summer school students who have ended the spring semester or school year with a grade designation of Incomplete “I”. These packets will be made available for students who are not able to attend our summer programming offered at each of our Middle Schools.

Extended School Year (ESY) Services for Students in Special Education

Extended School Year (ESY) services is an individualized instructional program for eligible students with disabilities that is provided beyond the regular school year. The need for ESY services must be determined on an individual basis by the admission, review, and dismissal (ARD) committee.

Bastrop ISD will offer Extended School Year Services during the July 20 - August 6 Jump Start program dates. Each student's schedule will be based on their unique needs as determined by the ARD Committee. English Learner/Newcomer Programming

Students who are new to the country (less than three years in U.S. schools) and require additional support for language acquisition can choose to receive support during the July 20 - August 6 Jump-Start dates. Support for students will include individualized instruction via small, teacher led groups, vocabulary acquisition and word study, and practice using learned vocabulary through speaking via virtual format. Buckle up for an amazing around-the-world virtual adventure! Interested BISD students in grades 5-8 will be able to participate in a worldwide trip (from their couch) to explore the beauty and diversity of planet Earth. From the islands of the Caribbean to Africa, Australia and beyond the kids will learn about our global community through at-home kits that include crafts, cooking projects and science activities led by our ACE coordinators.

The ACE program will operate June 1-July 9 through Google Classroom and include opportunities for students to interact with coordinators and each other in a virtual format.
