DEPARTMENT ACTIVITY REPORT

The Department Activity Report provides a summary of all law enforcement activities handled by the Bastrop ISD Police Department. The data is used to evaluate call volume, call types, officer caseload, response time, and crime trends. The data is also used as a tool to develop effective methods for assigning and/or allocating law enforcement resources to meet district needs.

Bastrop County Emergency Communications provides dispatching and communications services for the Bastrop ISD Police Department. Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) data reflecting the number of requested calls for service, response time, and call type received by Bastrop ISD Police Department is provided to the Chief of Police. Bastrop ISD police officers log their daily activities that provide data related to law enforcement initiated or campus-based requests for service. The Chief of Police reviews the data, prepares an activity report, and submits the findings to the BISD Superintendent.

This Department Activity Report provides data related to law enforcement activities and calls for service handled by Bastrop ISD Police Department during the reporting period of August 1, 2019 through March 13, 2020.

LAW ENFORCEMENT RESPONSE DATA

Bastrop ISD police officers receive dispatched calls for service from Bastrop County Emergency Communications and receive additional campus-based requests for service and engage in officer-related activities generally not dispatched through Bastrop County Emergency Communications. Campus-based requests and officer-initiated activities might include providing assistance to administrators with student/parent disruption or behavior issues, investigating criminal offenses, conducting follow-up investigations, engaging in campus patrol, conducting campus safety assessments, facilitating emergency drills, and providing routine police activities.

Calls for Service

Bastrop ISD Police Department responds to a variety of calls for service. Bastrop County Emergency Communications collects information by call type.

Table 1 shows the number of calls responded to by Bastrop ISD Police Department from August 2019 – March 2020. Of the 1,206 dispatched calls, 400 required a secondary BISD PD unit to respond and assist.

HISTORICAL DATA COMPARISONS

Calls for Service

After initial increases the first three months of 2019-2020, Bastrop ISD Police Department experienced a decrease in the monthly number of calls for law enforcement service from November 2019 – March 2020 compared to November 2018 – March 2019. Bastrop ISD Police Department experienced an overall decrease in calls of 9.2% compared to the same period in 2018-19.

Table 4 shows the difference and percentage changes in the number of calls per month in 2018-2019 and 2019-2020.

Response Time

Bastrop ISD Police Department has experienced an overall average decrease in response time regarding calls for law enforcement service for 2019-20 of 00:03:55 or -31% compared to response times in 2018-19.

Arrest Data

Bastrop ISD Police Department experienced an overall decrease in the number arrests for 2019-20 compared to 2018- 9. Overall, 51 fewer arrests were made from August 2019 – March 2020 for a decrease of 47.7%.

CONCLUSION

In law enforcement, it is important to avoid taking credit for a reduction in calls (crime) as that requires taking credit for an increase in calls (crime). Several variables determine the number of calls received during a time period that are out of the control of the Bastrop ISD Police Department. Based on changes made in 2019-2020 regarding number of officers, the data suggest the following:

- The number of service calls declined overall after increases in monthly calls from August October 2019. This decline may be related to the presence of officers being on campus regularly. Thus, having officers present on all campuses appears to have had a positive impact on the number of calls.
- While the type of calls varied widely during each month, Assist Complainant (18.4%) and Y Assist at Campus (12.4%) calls were relatively consistent each month and comprised 30.8% of the total 1,206 dispatched calls.
- From September November 2019, Disturbance and Drug calls comprised 16.4%, 15.5%, and 14.7% of total calls. This percentage declined from December 2019 March 2020 to well under 10% of total calls each month. This decline suggests that having officers on campus may create a deterrence for these activities.
- The reduction in response times to calls indicates that officers being present regularly on campus is having a positive impact on how quickly calls are handled by Bastrop ISD Police Department.

- The number of arrests decreased dramatically during 2019-20. This reduction is partially due to the change in how cases are accepted for THC and marijuana possession. More data is needed to ascertain if the overall reduction in arrests may be attributed to officers being present and more visible on campus.
- These reductions in calls, response times, and arrests occurred despite an increase in student population in 2019-20.

Although the data suggest Bastrop ISD Police Department's efforts are having a positive effect in our schools, we still have areas we can enhance and improve to ensure the safety and security of our students and staff remains our top priority. Improvements may be made in the following ways:

- Increasing the number of officers and campus monitors and prioritizing their presence in and around campuses, especially in between classes and at lunch, will not only improve safety and security, but also allow them to develop effective working relationships with administrators, faculty, staff, and students.
- Adding video monitoring systems and including the ability for safety and security personnel to view videos on their mobile devices and office computers will enhance surveillance and potentially help improve response times.
- Installing vaping and bullying software systems with the ability to monitor these activities in realtime will allow us to respond more quickly.
- Training safety and security personnel in SAMA, mental health, single officer response to active shooter events, gang affiliation and narcotic identification, firearms, self-defense, and needs of district and community will allow Bastrop ISD PD to identify and to respond to these activities in efficient and effective ways to ensure each situation is handled properly according to law enforcement and Bastrop ISD standards.
- A redesign of the Police Departments webpage creates more of a professional appearance, allows for additional safety information for our stakeholders at every age level, provides factual data-driven information for the public we serve, and gives all stakeholders legal information required by law.
