#### DEPARTMENT ACTIVITY REPORT

Bastrop County Emergency Communications provides dispatching and communications services for the Bastrop ISD Police Department. Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) data is provided to the Chief of Police, which reflects the number of requested calls for service, response time, and call type received by Bastrop ISD Police Department. The Department Activity Report provides accurate data pertaining to the number and types of law enforcement related activities and calls for service handled by the Bastrop ISD Police Department. Additionally, Bastrop ISD police officers log their daily activities which provide data related to law enforcement initiated or campus based requests for service. The Chief of Police shall review the data, prepare an activity report, and submit the findings to the BISD Superintendent.

This Department Activity Report provides data related to law enforcement activities and calls for service handled by Bastrop ISD Police Department during the reporting period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.

#### STATISTICS

Bastrop ISD police officers receive dispatched calls for service from Bastrop County Emergency Communications. Additionally, officers receive campus based requests for service and engage in self-initiated police related activities which are not generally dispatched through Bastrop County Emergency Communications. Campus based requests and officer initiated activities might include providing assistance to administrators with student/parent disruption or behavior issues, investigating criminal offenses, conducting follow-up investigations, engaging in campus patrol, conducting campus safety assessments, facilitating emergency drills, or providing routine police activities.

#### Law Enforcement Response Data

From July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, the Bastrop ISD Police Department responded to the following number of law enforcement related events:

- Dispatched and Campus based calls for service (Table 1- Table 12) - 1,657

#### **Calls for Service by Officer**

Bastrop ISD Police Department responds to a variety of calls for service and Bastrop County Emergency Communications collects information by call type.

#### **Calls for Service**

Bastrop ISD Police Department has experienced a change in the number of calls for law enforcement service.

In July 2019, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 17 total calls for service. In July 2020, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 8 calls for service. The percentage change in calls for service when comparing August 2020 data to August 2019 indicates a decrease of 52.9% in dispatched calls for service

- In August 2019, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 110 total calls for service. In August 2020, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 110 calls for service. There was no percentage change in calls for service when comparing August 2020 data to August 2019.
- In September 2019, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 195 total calls for service. In September 2020, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 115 calls for service. The percentage change in calls for service when comparing September 2020 data to September 2019 indicates a decrease of 41% in dispatched calls for service.
- In October 2019, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 206 total calls for service.
   In October 2020, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 149 calls for service.
   The percentage change in calls for service when comparing October 2020 data to
   October 2019 indicates a decrease of 27.7% in dispatched calls for service.
- In November 2019, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 164 total calls for service. In November 2020, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 163 calls for service. The percentage change in calls for service when comparing November 2020 data to November 2019 indicates a decrease of .6% in dispatched calls for service.
- In December 2019, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 95 total calls for service. In December 2020, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 130 calls for service. The percentage change in calls for service when comparing December 2020 data to December 2019 indicates an increase of 36.8% in dispatched calls for service.
- In January 2020, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 151 total calls for service. In January 2021, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 151 calls for service. There was no percentage change in calls for service when comparing January 2021 data to January 2020.
- In February 2020, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 172 total calls for service. In February 2021, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 131 calls for service. The percentage change in calls for service when comparing February 2021 data to February 2020 indicates a decrease of 23.8% in dispatched calls for service.

- In March 2020, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 113 total calls for service. In March 2021, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 166 calls for service. The percentage change in calls for service when comparing March 2021 data to March 2020 indicates an increase of 46.9% in dispatched calls for service.
- In April 2020, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 32 total calls for service. In April 2021, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 242 calls for service. The percentage change in calls for service when comparing April 2021 data to April 2020 indicates an increase of 656.3% in dispatched calls for service.
- In May 2020, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 12 total calls for service. In May 2021, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 235 calls for service. The percentage change in calls for service when comparing May 2021 data to May 2020 indicates an increase of 1858.3% in dispatched calls for service.
- In June 2020, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 7 total calls for service. In June 2021, Bastrop ISD Police Department received 57 calls for service. The percentage change in calls for service when comparing June 2021 data to June 2020 indicates an increase of 714.3% in dispatched calls for service.

#### **Response Time**

Bastrop ISD Police Department has experienced a change in response time regarding calls for law enforcement service.

- In July 2019, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department to arrive on scene after being dispatched was 00:14:14. In July 2020, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department was 00:14:15. The data indicates an increase in response time of 00:00.01.
- In August 2019, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department to arrive on scene after being dispatched was 00:10:49. In August 2020, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department was 00:04:40. The data indicates a decrease in response time of 00:06:09.
- In September 2019, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department to arrive on scene after being dispatched was 00:06:08. In September 2020, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department was 00:03:46. The data indicates a decrease in response time of 00:02:22.
- In October 2019, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department to arrive on scene after being dispatched was 00:15:39. In October 2020, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department was 00:09:22. The data indicates a decrease in response time of 00:06:17.

- In November 2019, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department to arrive on scene after being dispatched was 00:07:29. In November 2020, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department was 00:04:39. The data indicates a decrease in response time of 00:02:50.
- In December 2019, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department to arrive on scene after being dispatched was 00:06:18. In December 2020, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department was 00:04:02. The data indicates a decrease in response time of 00:02:16.
- In January 2020, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department to arrive on scene after being dispatched was 00:08:48. In January 2021, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department was 00:12:01. The data indicates an increase in response time of 00:03:13.
- In February 2020, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department to arrive on scene after being dispatched was 00:08:23. In February 2021, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department was 00:05:52. The data indicates a decrease in response time of 00:02:31.
- In March 2020, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department to arrive on scene after being dispatched was 00:06:23. In March 2021, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department was 00:04:48. The data indicates a decrease in response time of 00:01:35.
- In April 2020, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department to arrive on scene after being dispatched was 00:04:47. In April 2021, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department was 00:05:20. The data indicates an increase in response time of 00:00:33.
- In May 2020, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department to arrive on scene after being dispatched was 00:05:43. In May 2021, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department was 00:05:47. The data indicates an increase in response time of 00:00:04.
- In June 2020, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department to arrive on scene after being dispatched was 00:03:17. In June 2021, the average response time for Bastrop ISD Police Department was 00:04:39. The data indicates an increase in response time of 00:01:22.

#### **Conclusion**

Data from the Department Activity Report provides a summary of all law enforcement activities handled by the Bastrop ISD Police Department. The data is used to evaluate call volume, call types, officer caseload, response time, and crime trends. The data is also used as a tool to develop effective methods for assigning and/or allocating law enforcement resources to meet district needs.

In law enforcement you never want to take credit when calls (crime) goes down because you will assume the responsibility when calls (crime) goes up. However, it appears that calls (crime) have been on the decline since a spike in September. This could have been from the students adjusting to officers being on campus regularly. It appears that officers being present on campus is having a positive impact in the reduction of calls (crime). The reduction in response times to calls is also an indicator of the officers being present regularly on campus. These reductions occurred with an increase in student population.

We still have work to do. The safety and security of our students and staff is our top priority.
