A.	Safety and Security Updates <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ted Coleman went over the findings of the Intruder Detection Audit. There were a few maintenance issues that have been repaired.• Discussion was held regarding TEA's consideration of having surprise drills during audit visits.• Ashley Mutschink asked a question regarding drills conducted during passing periods or when students are in open areas. Discussion ensued. Mr. Coleman also mentioned that he will be

	<p>involved in planning drills on the school buses.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ted Coleman shared that Stop the Bleed Training for administrators and teachers was completed this summer with BISD PD officers, BCSO officers, and nurses from Ally Health providing instruction. Plans are in the works for employees of Operations and Maintenance departments to attend Stop the Bleed Training. • Barry Edwards gave the following update regarding the construction going on throughout the district this summer. All campuses now have a secure entry. Mr. Coleman added that the badge in/badge out system is working very well and the panic button was discussed. • Chief Bunch also gave an update on the number of police officers working for Bastrop ISD. We have currently have 19 police officers employed. <p>B. Progress on District Safety and Security</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ted Coleman reported that the digital mapping of all campuses and buildings that the Critical Response Group has created is complete and will be finalized at the end of this month. • Chief Bunch gave an update on the completion of fencing at the campuses and an update on the completion of remaining construction projects. • An update was given by Chief Bunch regarding the status of grant funding and the enhancements to security. • Discussion was held regarding forming a committee to review and follow Behavior Threat Assessment cases throughout the years. The Behavior Threat Assessment software that is used is StudentSafe by Raptor.
