TPSP allows scholars to enhance their academic opportunities by extending the learning in the classroom into the Gifted & Talented classroom. WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

1st GRADE - Songwriter's Club

Miss Mary Mack...a song or story or both? It is both! Stories can be written into songs & songs tell stories. Scholars have explored songs & nursery rhymes as storytelling devices. We have learned the difference between rhyming, repetition, & alliteration & have seen how songs have characters, a setting, beginning, middle, & end just like stories. The next part of this project will be writing a personal narrative & turning it into a song!

2nd GRADE - Secret Lives Of Public Spaces

Where have you been? This was the question that started this project. After listing all of the places scholars have been, we determined that some places are considered public places & some are private places. Public places are for everyone, & private places are for you & your family. We took a look at where we are located in the world. We went from the world to the continent to the country to the state & to the city in which we live. Scholars went on 2 virtual field trips, Bastrop State Park & Yellowstone National Park.
