Attendance

Texas law requires that students attend school at least 90% of the school year

8 absences the first semester

10 absences the second semester

Credit Loss

After the student has missed a class more than 8 times during the 1st semester or 10 times during the 2nd semester, there will be an attendance hold on the student's transcript.

This means that the student will not receive that credit until attendance hours are made up.

**ALL ATTENDANCE HOURS MUST BE MADE UP
WITHIN THE ACADEMIC YEAR**

If hours are not made up in time, the student will have to make-up missed credit through credit recovery.

Gateway - Disciplinary Alternative Campus

What is Intersession?

- ❖ Intersession allows students the opportunity to recover credits for classes failed in the fall semester.

- ❖ Ms. Fox will notify you the week of February 3, 2020 if you have classes to recover.

- ❖ Spring After School Credit Recovery will begin Tuesday, February 18, 2020. This program is available Monday-Thursday from 4:15 pm - 6:00 pm in A112.

- ❖ You may either ride the bus home or be picked up in front of the school. **If you need bus transportation, you will need to complete a Beyond the Bell form. Pick up and return to the form to Ms. Fox in A112.**

- ❖ **After School Credit Recovery is Free. Summer School is not!**





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Academic Integrity Policy

At CCHS, maintaining academic integrity is very important. Please be aware that there are consequences when a student does not maintain academic integrity by cheating, plagiarising, forging, or fabricating their work.





Academic Integrity Policy

1st Offense: All students involved will be referred to the Assistant Principal (documentation required)

Parents will be notified by the teacher and the AP

The Assistant Principal will notify all other teachers, coaches, sponsors

Counselors will be notified

The student will receive the lowest grade possible according to policy on the work with make-up opportunities allowed with a maximum grade of 70%

If the student is involved in extracurricular activities, they will be subject to the consequences stipulated by their organization, sponsor, and/or coach

Student will receive a one-day Saturday School

Student will be reminded of the Academic Integrity Policy and the consequences for the second offense

Student will be given another copy of the Academic Integrity Policy

2nd Offense (in any class):

All students involved will be referred to the Assistant Principal (documentation required)

Student will receive one day of ISS

Parents will be notified by the teacher and the AP

If the student is involved in extracurricular activities, they will be subject to the consequences stipulated by their organization, sponsor, and/or coach

If the 2nd offense is in same Pre AP or AP class, student may be removed from the Pre AP or AP class to an on level class with grade average to stand as is

Student will receive the lowest grade possible according to policy with no make-up opportunities allowed

3rd Offense (in any class):

Indicates a persistent pattern and the following serious consequences will occur:

Student will receive the lowest grade possible according to policy with no make-up opportunities allowed

Student will receive two days of ISS

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College Career Military Readiness (CCMR)

In order for you to have Senior Late Start, an Aide period, or Senior Early Release next school year, you need to have met CCMR.

To meet CCMR:

- College Ready scores for SAT, ACT or TSI
- Score a 3 or higher on an AP exam
- Enlist in the military
- Earn a certification
