Safety First – IDs Every Day, All Day

We are starting to notice more and more students not wearing/displaying their IDs. It is very important to know exactly who belongs and does not belong on our campus every day. Starting Monday, we will conduct ID checks during 1st period until further notice. Students who do not have an ID will report to the designated location announced to receive a “temporary ID” for the day. We will be tracking the number of times a student does not have an ID. Students who are continuously without an ID during these “sweeps” will receive consequences. Students will receive a new ID and charged \$3 to the obligation list each time we have to print a replacement. If you know you lost your ID, bring \$3 to the AP office to have a new ID printed.
