Deadline to Order AP Exams This Friday 3/15/2019

The deadline to order AP exams is this Friday, March 15th. Students may register for AP exams with a \$15 deposit for each exam. Final payment for all AP exams is due April 29, 2019. See Mrs. Medley in the AP office to register.

Senior Release Requirement

Juniors who would like a senior release period next year, must meet at least one of the CCMR (College, Career, and Military Readiness) Indicators.

CCMR Indicators:

- 3+ on AP exam
- SAT Math=530+ Reading=480+
- ACT=23+ composite with 19+ Math and 19+ English
- TSI Reading=351+, Math= 350+, Writing=340+ with 5 on essay or 350 with 4 on essay
- Dual Credit (3 hours in ELA OR Math; Or 9 hours in any other course)
- Industry Based Certification
- Enlisted in Armed Services
- Career and Technology Education Coherent Sequence and aligned with Industry Based Certification

Students who want to retest on the TSI exam need to register at the College and Career Center. If a student has not met the minimum score after taking two exams, the student must participate in a TSI intervention session before retesting.
