1. Opening, Pledge, Recognitions & Presentations, and Open Forum

A. Meeting Called to Order

President Allen called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. A quorum of board members was present. The meeting was duly called and notice of this meeting was posted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.

D. Opening Prayer

Glenn Peterson offered the opening prayer.

E. Student Speaker on Character Education Trait for January - Loyalty Estrella "Star" Martinez, a Senior at CCHS, spoke on Loyalty. Star is on the

varsity basketball team, is on the Student Council, a member of the Superintendent's Student Advisory Council and is a Quad C student. She is also President of her youth group at church. Star's parents are Maria DeLeon and Carlos Martinez.

F. Introduction of Representatives from BHS and CCHS Superintendent's Student Advisory Council (SSAC)

Superintendent Murray introduced CCHS Senior Wyatt Buckner and Genesis Senior Adilynn Henderson, representatives from the Superintendent's Student Advisory Councils.

G. Recognitions and Presentations

1. Recognition of Bastrop ISD Board of Trustees for School Board Appreciation Month

Superintendent Steve Murray thanked School Board members for their service on the board. Mr. Murray also thanked Board members' spouses for allowing

their spouses to serve. Mr. Murray and principals presented board members with tokens of appreciation and thanked them for their service.

2. Public Hearing

A. Public Hearing on Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR)

Assistant Superintendent Janie Pollard opened the Public Hearing on the Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR) at 7:04 p.m. Mrs. Pollard reviewed the 2014-2015 TAPR Annual Report. She reported that Bastrop ISD's 2015 Accountability Rating was Met Standard and the 2015 Special Education Determination Status was Meets Requirements. Mrs. Pollard reported that the Annual Report would be posted on the district's website within 2 weeks and added that paper copies of the report would be available at the BISD Service Center as well as on each campus in the district.

Mrs. Pollard asked for comments or questions. There being no questions or comments, the Public Hearing was closed at 7:19 p.m.

3. Superintendent's Report and Board Discussion

A. Curriculum Report

1. Update on Colorado River Collegiate Academy

CRCA Principal Martin Conrardy presented an update on the Colorado River Collegiate Academy. Mr. Conrardy reviewed the vision, mission and core values for CRCA and reported that the class of 2018 has earned 438 college hours. In addition, he reported that CRCA has 51 College Ready high school freshmen and 50 College Ready high school sophomores, and 101 of 106 CRCA students are taking ACC classes at this time. Mr. Conrardy introduced some CRCA students and gave thanks to Mr. Murray and the School Board for their continued support and commitment to the program.

2. Update on Quad C Program

Associate Principals Liz Wysocki & Krystal Gabriel provided an update on the Quad C Program. They reported that the Quad C Program will have their first graduating class this year. Ms. Wysocki and Ms. Gabriel also reported that Quad C students had earned 1,077 total BISD credit hours. Two Quad C students gave testimonials about their experiences with the Quad C program. Ms. Wysocki and Ms. Gabriel thanked Mr. Murray and the School Board for their support.

3. Sale and / or Recycling Out of Adoption Instructional Materials Information was provided to the Board. There was no discussion.

4. Course Guide Update

Penne' Liefer presented an update on the 2016-2017 Course Selection Guide. She stated that the goal was to produce a user friendly version for all stakeholders, specifically students and parents. Ms. Liefer said that the course selection guides will go out to the public at the end of the month.

5. Grade Classification Regulation Update

Penne' Liefer presented an update on Grade Classification revisions. She reported that BISD will modify the administrative regulation to reflect the following grade classification requirements: 5 credits after the Freshmen year to become a Sophomore (was previously 7 credits); 11 credits after the Sophomore year to become a Junior (was previously 13 credits); and 18 credits after the Junior year to become a Senior (was previously 19 credits). Ms. Liefer reported that due to the changes, a total of 211 students will have the opportunity to stay within their graduation cohorts at BHS and CCHS.

D. Operations Report

1. Demographic Update

Trent Smith with Templeton Demographics presented a Demographic Study for the Spring 2016. He reviewed the 10 year forecast by grade level and by campus. Mr. Smith reported that Bastrop ISD is projected to reach 11,000 students by 2018 and enrollment for 2025-26 is forecasted at 13,881 students.

E. Communications / Community Services Report

1. Strategic Design Update

Emily Parks presented an update on Strategic Design. She reported that the district will hold two Strategic Design Summits on Thursday, January 21st. She added that the summits are open to the public and will feature middle and high school students from across the district discussing how we can transform education in BISD.

Ms. Parks also reported that the district recently started a district branding process which will support the strategic design and work to unify the district as a whole once the strategic design is in place. She added that the district is working on a "new image" and will launch a PR campaign in the near future to share good, positive news. Ms. Parks reported that there are some great representatives in the group.

2. Rising Star Distinction (Daycare)

Emily Parks reported that the district daycare, under the direction of Kayla Russell, received a Rising Star Designation. She reported that the Emile daycare received 4 stars, the highest rating available, while Cedar Creek Elementary daycare received 3 stars. Ms. Parks praised her staff for taking the initiative to improve the quality of the programs, adding that BISD is truly improving education at all levels.
