A. Consider Approval of Application for Low Attendance Day Waiver Request to TEA

Sandra Callahan reported that due to low attendance on January 28, 2014 and October 31, 2013, the district would like to request a low attendance state waiver for these two days. She explained that the waiver allows the district to request that an instructional day with attendance at least 10 percentage points below the last school year's average attendance due to inclement weather, health, safety-related, or other issues be excused from ADA calculations for the current school years. Mrs. Callahan said that if the waivers are approved, it should improve the district's ADA.

Mark Martyn moved and John Eaton seconded to approve the filing of an Attendance State Waiver Request to TEA as per the Student Attendance Accounting Handbook, Section 3.3.3 as presented. President Allen asked for comments or questions. There being none, President Allen called for a vote.
