1. Budget Information

CFO Sandra Callahan presented 2014-2015 preliminary budget information. Mrs. Callahan stated that the budget is scheduled to be adopted at the June 3rd board meeting.

Mrs. Callahan reviewed the budget needs assessment used for building the 2014-15 budget. She reported that the budget is based upon projected enrollment of 9,810 students and average daily attendance is estimated at 8,939 for funding purposes. Mrs. Callahan reported that she doesn't anticipate an increase in the tax rate this year.

Mrs. Callahan reviewed property value history and reported that it is back on an upward trend following the wildfires. Estimates show a 4% property value growth next year. Mrs. Callahan reviewed general fund revenue comparison and reported a projected \$1.2 million increase in revenues next year. She reviewed the district's fund balance history and estimates with policy goal.
