1. Report from Belt, Harris, Pechacek, LLLP 2013-2014 Audit

Nathan Krupke with Belt, Harris, Pechacek, LLLP presented the 2013-2014 audit. Mr. Krupke reported a clean opinion audit and he commended Mrs. Callahan and her staff for a great job complying with all of the regulations.

2. Bond Rating and Bond Sale

Information was provided to the Board. Mrs. Callahan reported the district successfully sold its Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2014 on November 4, 2014 saving the district a total of \$1,499,940. She added that based on these results, the District has achieved \$8,723,487 of savings for District taxpayers since year 2011. In addition, Mrs. Callahan reported that the District's bond rating was upgraded to AA-.

B. Curriculum Report

1. Quad C Program Annual Update

Dr. Hewitt and Ms. Olivares introduced Associate Principals Liz Wysocki and Tammy Underwood. Ms. Underwood and Ms. Wysocki presented an annual update on the Quad C Program. They reported that the program allows students to achieve up to 36 college hours (tuition free) before graduating from BISD while learning about servant leadership and participating in community service activities for the BISD community. Ms. Underwood and Ms. Wysocki recognized the Bastrop Education Foundation for awarding a \$5,000grant to each campus to go towards books. Mr. Murray reported that he was interviewed by KLRU today for the CRCA campus, and added that the Quad C program helped make the early college high school a reality. He commended Ms. Underwood and Ms. Wysocki for doing an outstanding job.
